Town of Northumberland Public Hearing November 9, 2023

The Public Hearing on the proposed 2024 Town Budget was called to order @ 8:00 AM by Deputy Supervisor John DeLisle. Following the salute to the flag, roll call was taken. Those attending included Deputy Supervisor John DeLisle; Councilman Paul Bolesh; and Councilman George Hodgson. Supervisor Willard Peck and Councilwoman Patricia Bryant were absent. Also attending was Clerk Denise Murphy; Town Attorney David Brennan and Building and Zoning Inspector Michael Terry.

Deputy Supervisor John DeLisle presented the proposed 2024 Town Budget and gave an overview of the proposed Budget. The 2024 Town Budget is under the 2% Tax Cap by roughly \$7,000. Deputy Supervisor John Delisle stated that the proposed 2024 Town Budget is fiscally conservative.
